#### **OUTDOOR SCIENCE CAMP (AGE 10 - 12)**

#### Nurture your queen. Watch the eggs. Grow your colony.

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#### **NEW ENRICHMENT COURSES**

#### WRITING (AGE 7 - 9 | 10 -12 | 13 - 16)

In this course for 7-16-year-olds, our experienced writing coaches will help students create their first story over 8 lessons. As the lessons progress, our coaches will break down the story writing process and the students will learn not only how to seek inspiration but also plan their own unique stories. Through creating their own adventure, students will learn the essential skills of creative writing such as plotting and crafting authentic characters.

#### FOR ADVANCE WRITERS

Taught by the playwright Dr. Heeger, this workshop will take students through the fundamentals of short story writing, from a story idea to a finished piece ready to publish.

In the first part of the workshop, students will read and analyse two classics of young adult literature: The Boy in the Striped Pajamas and A Sound of Thunder, to learn how published authors create compelling settings, characters, plots, backgrounds and themes. Next, they will practice their learning of these literary devices through guided writing exercises. They will then be ready to draft their own short story for class critique, and refine and format it to be e-published.

#### PUBLIC SPEAKING & SCIENCE (AGE 7 - 9 | 10 - 12)

This class takes an integrated approach that is designed to foster students' curiosity and inquisitiveness, and simultaneously empower them to articulate and communicate their discoveries and ideas.

The class is divided into four modules each focusing on one topic: the heart in a heartbeat, the science in your environment, chemistry at your home, and the joys and tribulations of a bug's life! These fascinating explorations into everyday phenomena prompt students to ask questions, to look at the world around them through a new set of lenses, to blend into their discoveries the occasional data analysis, and so broaden and widen their perimeters of knowledge.

## ENRICHMENT COURSE

#### SHAKESPEARE & DRAMATIC TEXT (AGE 10 - 12)

Myles O'Gorman, theatre director and double-first Cambridge graduate, will present two one-week intensives on Shakespeare, aimed at helping students gain key skills in understanding English Literature whilst also boosting their confidence in public speaking, and learning to use comedy and tragedy creatively in writing for modern audiences.

In Level 1, Myles will focus on comedy. With "A Midsummer Night's Dream' as the core text, students will learn how to perform, design and act for the stage. They will, by the end of the week, be able to perform sections of the text over Zoom and/or design their own staging of the play.

Level 2 will be an exploration into tragedy in Shakespeare. Myles will help students recognize the elements that make Shakespearean tragedies timeless classics in English Literature, and the internal and external struggles of the protagonists. Under Myles' guidance, students will write their own modern adaptation of a Shakespearean play.

#### POLICY DEBATE (AGE 13 & UP)

For aspiring advanced and competitive debaters! Policy debate is a strategic argument between two teams on a given topic. The team in affirmation must come up with a plan, a way to support the topic, in the form of a government policy. The team in negation tries to convince the judge that the plan is a bad idea. The rest of the debate centers around whether or not the plan should be enacted. You'll be happy to find that policy debate is a healthy combination of politics, philosophy, ethics, performance, and basically whatever you want it to be. This event will prepare you for every other speech and debate event. Policy is a space where you can do whatever you want, and make it as fun and challenging as you would like it.

#### **STAY TUNED!**

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#### GENETICS & THE WORLD (AGE 11 - 13)

Science and languages at the same time? This class takes an integrated approach that covers science, English, social issues, policy, and ethics all at the same time. From gene editing to cloning and ethics, climate change to conservation, and electricity to renewable energy, children will find themselves fascinated by the daily phenomena in nature, eager to ask questions through a new lense, stretched through occasional data analysis, and motivated to expand their perimeter of knowledge. Students will emerge as an inquisitive learner, and an empowered communicator of their wildest ideas.

#### **STAY TUNED**

#### SOCIAL STUDIES (AGE 13 & UP)

Why are certain countries rich and others poor? What role does demography play in economic development? Why do some populations grow and some decline?

Level 1 of the Social Studies course seeks to answer these questions by considering themes related to colonialism, theories of modern economic development, differences between MEDCs and LEDCs, regional and world trade and aid. There is a particular emphasis on the influence of migration, effects of war, international jurisprudence as well as anti- and pro-natalist policies.

In Level 2, these themes are explored in depth in the context of Asia, with case studies used extensively to help students to understand the forces at play. Among the scenarios investigated to better understand the impact of wars and borders on migration are Vietnamese refugees in Hong Kong in the 1970s and recent asylum seekers from the African continent. A study of China's migrant workers provides the focus for discussing the concepts of urbanization and rural-urban migration patterns.


